Filmmaker/Director Karen Aptekar announces that her documentary film, "Saving Evan White" about the troubles medical dependant underage individual and their families go through when they "age-out" of their pediatric benefits at 21, is nominated for a Texas Lone Star Advanced Media Emmy.

The 13-minute short documentary received 4 Bronze - 2009 30th Annual Telly Awards in the categories of "Use of Music", "Charitable", "Low Budget" and "Social Issues". The film was screened at the 2009 SXSW Reel Women Showcase and won a Bronze Remi Award at the 2009 42 Annual WorldFest-Houston International Independent Film and Video Festival in the category of "Social/Economic Issues".

A 3-minute advocacy version of "Saving Evan White" was made and is being distributed to our Texas State Representatives and Senators as part of the effort to effectuate change and to pass SB-2241, the bill would create a "Hospital Level of Care Waiver" and keep families together.
